This means that **Pre-school is only open to parents of children who are key workers** (please see previous emails). **The children of key workers should only be accessing their Pre-school place when their parent has no other alternative as they have to work.** If another parent or family member living with you can look after your child, then I would urge you to take this route to reduce the number of children in Pre-school at any time. (Following the Government advice, having as few people together as possible).

However, the Pre-school staff and committee members like to think that Pre-school is not closed but is changing and evolving to meet the demands of Covid-19 (Coronavirus). None of us know how long these measures will be in place and these times feel strange and very uncertain. I know that many of us feel anxious at this time.

A few weeks is a long time for a young child and for parents trying to entertain your little ones.
